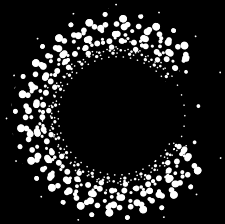

LIGHT LAYERING WITH CROMPTON

When designing and cultivating the ultimate space, there's nothing more important than creating an inviting and enjoyable atmosphere. So many of us forget that creating the right light stretches beyond simply flicking a switch. Light can have a profound affect on the look and feel of your surroundings by maximising the appearance and functionality of any space. Using more than one light source can also help balance a room by minimising glare and shadows, while adding depth and dimension.

AMBIENT LIGHTING/

As the base level of lighting, ambient lighting instantly makes any room appear more inviting and welcoming. You can achieve overall illumination and a comfortable level of brightness through the use of ceiling-mounted luminaires. Interested in more options? Downlights, spotlights, oysters, batten-fix, pendants and wall-mounted luminaires will also reach the same level of serenity and illumination.

TASK LIGHTING/

Providing a direct source of light for every day activities, task lighting is essential for reading, cooking, completing assignments, playing games or getting ready for the day ahead. Free of shadows and bright enough to prevent eye strain, task lighting can be achieved through the use of track lighting systems, spotlights, wall-mounted luminaires, pendants and under-cabinet luminaires.

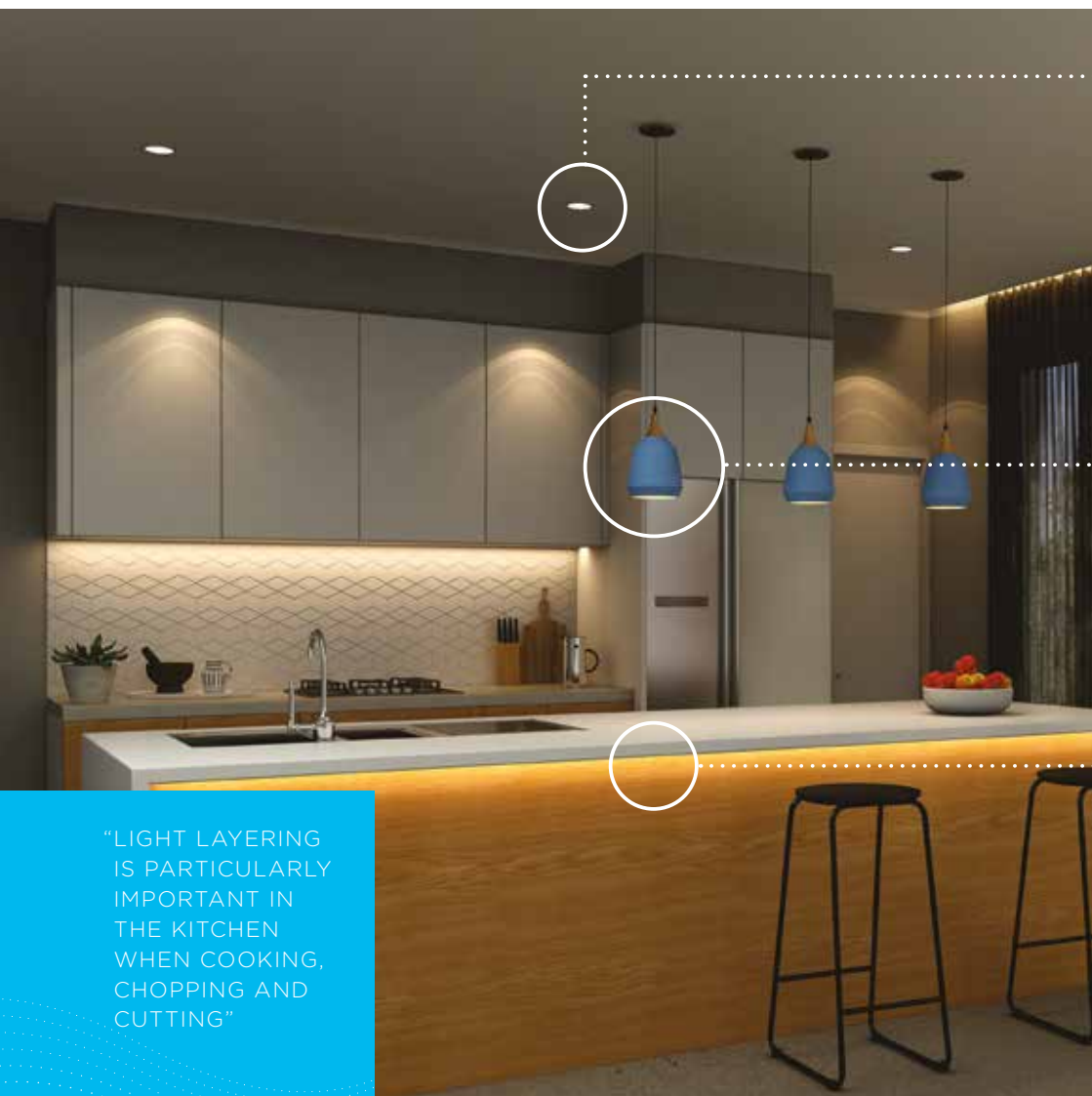
ACCENT LIGHTING/

Want to add a pop of drama to your favourite room? Accent lighting will do the trick! Not only does it create a visual interest, but it draws the eye to items such as mirrors, paintings or art displayed within the area. It can also be used to highlight architectural design elements and outdoor landscaping. Enjoy accent lighting through the use of pendants, under-cabinet luminaires, spotlights or track lighting systems.

LIGHT LAYERING YOUR KITCHEN

As the hub of the home, the kitchen sees it all. From amazing meals, to family conversations, entertaining moments and unforgettable memories – the kitchen is where we recount our days and relay cherished stories.

It's also where we handle some of the most dangerous items in the house. Light layering is particularly important in the kitchen when cooking, chopping and cutting. Task lighting in this case is very useful.

HANDY HINTS FOR LIGHTING YOUR KITCHEN:

- 1/ Task lighting can help ensure safe chopping and cooking, eliminating the creation of shadows
- 2/ Softer and ambient lighting sets the scene for an ideal after-dinner conversation
- 3/ As the kitchen is a hub of all kinds of activities, controlling different light sources separately helps you create the perfect light for the right atmosphere and time of day

- 4/ LEDs provide an efficient light that is ideal for under cabinet lighting
- 5/ Pendant lights are the ultimate accessory to any dining table. They can segment the room and create a dining ambience. Simply ensure the light rests a minimum of 80cm above the table or bench

LAYER 1/ AMBIENT LIGHTING

Downlights placed around the perimeter of the room or a ceiling-mounted luminaire centrally positioned.

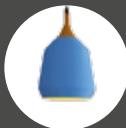

LAYER 2/ TASK LIGHTING

A row of miniature pendants or a track lighting system positioned over an island bench. Under-cabinet luminaries including strip lighting or battens for other work areas. They can also act as accent lighting when other task and ambient lighting is turned off.

LAYER 3/ ACCENT LIGHTING

Strip lighting under bench-tops and under cabinets to enhance features such as splash backs, inside glass cabinets and shelving.

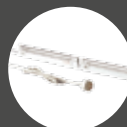

It's where we begin and end our days, which is why the bathroom provides an excellent opportunity to blend both function and style.

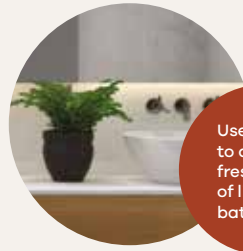
As it's a multifunctional area, the concept of light layering is particularly applicable when aiming to create the right atmosphere. While personal grooming requires good task lighting, creating a private retreat requires lighting that radiates a sense of calm.

HANDY HINTS FOR LIGHTING YOUR BATHROOM:

- 1/ Feeling luxurious? There are now shower heads with inbuilt lights!
- 2/ Spa and pamper pendants are a great way to update any old bathroom
- 3/ Sensor controlled lighting is a helpful way to ensure a quick and safe visit to the bathroom in the middle of the night
- 4/ Select products with a suitable waterproof rating. This is known as an IP rating



Use plants to create a fresh layer of life in your bathroom

LAYER 1/ AMBIENT LIGHTING

Ceiling-mounted lights such as oysters, pendants and central chandeliers will provide sufficient light, while 3-in-1 bathroom luminaires with integrated heating lamps and exhausts are a deluxe option.

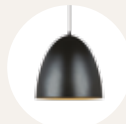
LAYER 2/ TASK LIGHTING

Pendants placed either side of the mirror or downlights placed directly above the mirror can achieve adequate task lighting. Wall-mounted luminaires on both sides of the mirror will provide even, shadow-free facial illumination, perfect for getting ready each day.

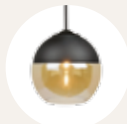

LAYER 3/ ACCENT LIGHTING

Use lighting under bench-tops and in shower recesses or storage nooks to enhance features such as splash backs. Under-cabinet lighting will make those pesky middle of the night trips to the bathroom safer and easier

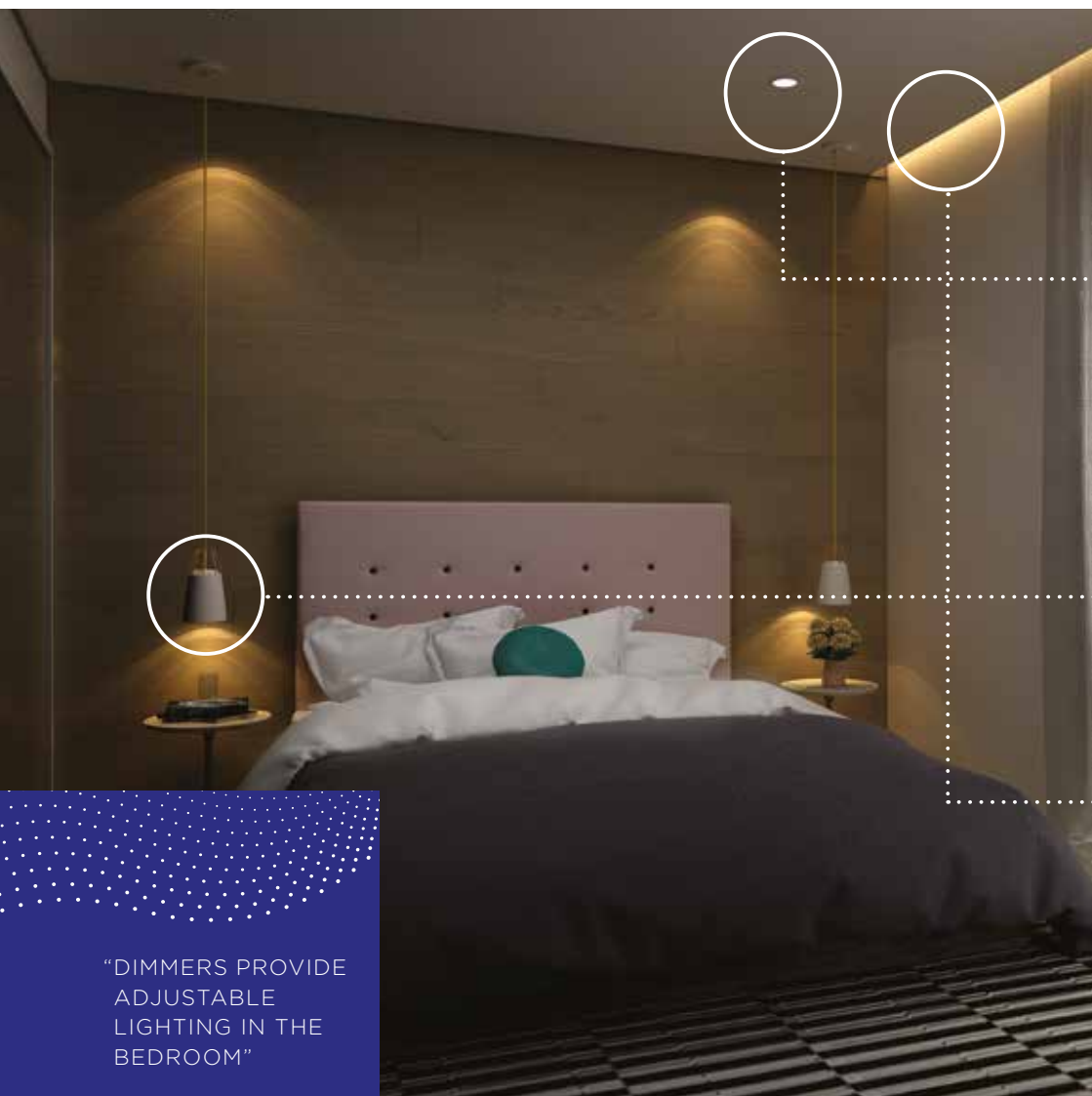

LIGHT LAYERING YOUR BEDROOM

Besides a stellar meditation app or the world's most comfortable bed, a good lighting plan is the best answer to creating a bedroom filled with tranquillity and relaxation.

HANDY HINTS FOR LIGHTING YOUR BEDROOM:

- 1/ Consider a well-suited lampshade for bedside lamps so you're not exposed to harsh light while trying to fall asleep
- 2/ When hanging pendants as reading lights, place them above and behind the reader to help prevent shadows
- 3/ Dimmers provide adjustable lighting in the bedroom. This is particularly important as it allows control over the mood of the room
- 4/ Lights in cupboards and wardrobes help when choosing outfits or looking for particular clothing items

LAYER 1/ AMBIENT LIGHTING

Ceiling-mounted lights such as pendants and chandeliers, suspended centrally will provide adequate light for dressing and seeing into drawers. Close-to-ceiling luminaires like oysters or downlights in closets give good general light without taking up too much space.

LAYER 2/ TASK LIGHTING

Small pendant lights and wall-mounted luminaires positioned over the bedside table will provide good task lighting for bedside reading.

LAYER 3/ ACCENT LIGHTING

A chandelier or pendant in the center of the room will add a sense of style and personality to any bedroom. You can accentuate photographs and artwork with an adjustable downlight.

Highlight artwork or sculptures by using a gimble downlight and adjusting the direction of the light



LAYER 1/ AMBIENT LIGHTING

Ensure downlights are placed around the perimeter of the room or centrally position a ceiling-mounted luminaire. Alternatively, enjoy a sense of light washing through the room with the help of strategically placed wall lights.

LAYER 2/ TASK LIGHTING

Lamps provide great reading light near armchairs, or position track lighting or a pendant light near the seating area to optimise the space. Pendant lighting above a dining table draws the eye and defines the space. Stairway lighting helps you safely use the stairs at night and adds an inviting glow to the space.

LAYER 3/ ACCENT LIGHTING

Highlight artwork or sculptures by placing up-lights in the floor for feature walls, track lighting or gimble downlights. Downlights and under cabinet lighting can also be used inside glass cabinets or shelving areas.
